THE REINTRODUCTION OF THE PROGRESS CENTRE

As educationists, we noted with concern, that some of our students are struggling with their academics hence the reinstatement of this centre. Pupils from Grade 3 – 6, who would have missed out on certain concepts, would be referred by their class teachers to the Progress Centre for remediation. This will be at most for an hour a day then the students go back into the mainstream. We do have a specialist teacher Mrs M. Phiri, who studied, "Special Needs". Our students will therefore benefit from her skills. A few benefits that can be derived from the Progress Centre/Remedial teaching are thus;

- Learners focus on their challenges
- Learners grow comfortably seeking help
- Helps to match learners with teachers who understand them better
- Builds confidence and self esteem and

• Prepares students for life-long success.

The Progress Centre will be effected when students are back at the physical school. In the meantime, Mrs Phiri will work together with the new teacher who will eventually take over the Grade 3 class when she commences teaching at the Progress Centre.
